VENUE & LOCATION:

The Forum will be hosted at Strathmore University, situated along Ole Sangale Road in the Madaraka area of Nairobi, Kenya. The University's campus is easily accessible from Lang'ata Road and lies a short distance from the Nairobi Central Business District, offering delegates a convenient and well-connected venue. Its modern facilities and serene environment make it a fitting setting for the deliberations of the Forum. Delegates are encouraged to plan their travel with Nairobi traffic in mind, particularly during peak morning and evening hours.

HOTEL, AIRBNB & ALTERNATIVE STAYS:

Delegates are expected to make their **own** accommodation arrangements to the venue in time for the start of the forum. There are several hotels near the venue namely;

For delegates who prefer a more residential or flexible stay, the neighboring environs of Langata, Madaraka, Nairobi West offer a wide range of high-quality Airbnb options. It is however important that when booking where to stay, kindly ensure it is within a 5–7km radius of Strathmore University to minimize morning and evening travel time.

TRANSPORTATION INTO AND AROUND NAIROBI

Nairobi City offers a variety of transportation options to suit different preferences. However, please note that the city experiences significant traffic congestion, particularly during peak hours (7:00 AM – 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM). We therefore kindly recommend that you plan your journeys with ample time to ensure smooth and stress-free arrival.

GETTING TO THE VENUE

Delegates are kindly requested to make their own transportation arrangements and aim to arrive at the venue in good time for the start of the sessions.



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AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Most of our recommended hotels offer convenient shuttle services from the airport. Alternatively, ride-hailing apps such as Uber and Bolt are widely available, reliable, and commonly used in Nairobi, providing a comfortable and convenient option for your arrival.

VISA AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To ensure a hassle-free entry into Kenya, we strongly advise all delegates to check the official e-Citizen portal and apply for the necessary Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) at least two weeks prior to your travel date.

VISAS

All participants are responsible for ensuring that they are in possession of the correct documentation prior to their departure into Kenya. A valid entry visa is required for most countries and can be obtained in advance from the Kenyan Embassy/High Commission in your country of residence. Ensure your passport is valid for at least six months from your arrival date. Check your visa requirements [here](#).

WEATHER

October in Nairobi is a delightful transitional month, as the city gently shifts from the dry season into the short rains. While rainfall tends to increase toward the end of the month, the days remain pleasantly warm, with temperatures typically ranging between 25°C and 28°C. Evenings and nights bring a refreshing coolness, with temperatures dropping to a comfortable 11°C to 14°C. Rain showers, when they occur, are generally moderate and often arrive in the afternoon or evening, allowing for plenty of bright and sunny moments throughout the day. This creates an overall agreeable climate, a lovely balance of warmth and occasionally refreshing showers. Considering this, we kindly recommend that all delegates pack light, breathable clothing for the daytime and a light jacket, sweater, or shawl for the cooler evenings.

The marketplace will remain open throughout the three days of the forum, providing ample opportunity for live demonstrations as well as B2B engagements and networking.

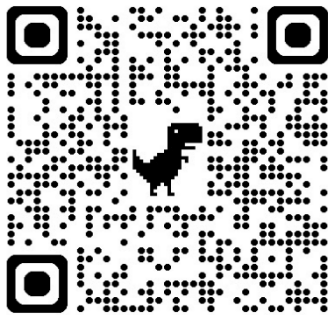
